
The Downtown Stratford Business Improvement Area Board of Directors is dedicated to improving the downtown as a business centre through marketing and beautification initiatives.

Membership in the Downtown Stratford BIA is automatic for businesses and property-owners in downtown Stratford. Membership fees are paid in the form of a levy that is included in City property taxes.

The BIA Board of Directors comprises up to nine individuals including a Stratford City Council Representative, a Chair Person, Vice-Chair and a Treasurer; and has sub-committees dedicated to addressing Christmas, Parking, Beautification, Marketing, and Advocacy & Education initiatives.

- To maintain Downtown Stratford as an active and viable area.
- To beautify the Downtown and to encourage preservation of downtown architectural heritage. We are not involved in the renovations - this is Heritage Stratford and the City.

# Vandalism

# Garbage

Curb-side pick-up takes place throughout the core early every Tuesday and Friday. Garbage should be placed in appropriate bags and left at the curb at closing time on Monday and Thursday. Each bag must have a city garbage tag attached. These tags can be purchased at City Hall and some convenience stores. For any overflowing garbage cans in the core please call public works at 519-271-0250 x259 or after hours at 519-271-0820.

Recycle: Blue-Box recycle should be placed curbside on Tuesdays at closing time. For what can and cannot be recycled call Kate Simpson, Waste Reduction Coordinator at 519-271-0250 ext. 279.

Snow Removal: The owner, occupant or person in charge of any property in the core area is required to clear the sidewalks adjacent to their property of all snow and ice throughout the winter. # Parking

Feedback for parking issues should be reported to the City Clerk's office at 519-271-0250 ext 237. To help ensure that there is plenty of parking for guests and visitors to the city, please insist that your staff use the FREE parking at the Cooper Site Lot on St. Patrick St., or the 12-HOUR parking spots located at the Kalbfleisch lot on Erie at St. Patrick St. There are also 12-hour metered spots located at the Police Station lot on St. Patrick St., and on Cobourg near Erie (behind Ontario St.).
