MONTHLY MESSAGE FROM OUR GENERAL MANAGER



It is April and looking back I would say March went out like a Lion! April is a great month as one starts to feel the change of season in your heart and in your bones. It is a fresh renewal as we see the spring flowers sprouting adding much needed colour to the palate after a long white winter.

While seasons have changed, the chaos & turmoil generated by the US president continues to live and breathe. April 28 is our Federal election and I urge you to get out and vote, to make sure your opinion

and values are counted. I am not endorsing any particular party, just encouraging you to vote. What you have to say truly matters and the outcome of the election will affect your business and your personal life. Sometimes we feel that the local candidate that we would like to have represent us has no chance of winning so why bother.

1. Your Vote Contributes to the Bigger Picture

Elections aren't just about one riding—every vote contributes to national trends. A stronger showing for your candidate's party, even in a loss, can influence future policy decisions, party platforms, and leadership directions.

2. Parties Notice Voter Support

If a party sees increased support in a riding, they may invest more resources there in the future, recruit stronger candidates, or adjust policies to align with voter interests.

3. Strength in Numbers

Voter turnout itself sends a message. If large numbers of people who share your views don't vote, politicians will assume those issues don't matter. Higher turnout means greater accountability.

4. Democracy Works When We Participate

Elections shape the future of the country. Even if the result isn't exactly what you hoped for, participating in the process ensures that your values and priorities are counted.

Skipping an election because of predicted outcomes is like refusing to cheer for your team because they're the underdog—every voice still matters, and the game isn't over until the final whistle. I know as I have been a Maple Leaf Fan for many many years!
