# **COMMUTER CUP CHALLENGE**





#### MapMISSIONS IN SPRING!



We are partnering with RTO4 to conduct MapMissions with AccessNow. MapMissions are coordinated efforts to put accessibility on the map of destinations and regions. The AccessNow app is free and is built on the Google Maps platform so it is super easy to use. It allows users to rate the accessibility of any public place—restaurant, B&B, boutique, festival, or trail. AccessNow, the company that developed the app, provides introductory training for

users before they set out on their "mission," which is followed by a reflection session where users and mappers describe what they learned from the experience. It's a wonderful way of getting to know your neighbourhood through the lens of accessibility. If you are interested in the St. Marys and Stratford MapMission, register below.

The Calm Before the Curtain Rises — Stratford Awaits the Storm of Applause

There is a peculiar kind of quiet in Stratford this time of year. It is not the stillness of sleep, nor the hush of hibernation. Rather, it is the collective inhale before the exhale of a season that will, once again, set this town alight. We are in the calm before the storm — the festival storm — and make no mistake, it is coming.

Every spring, as buds appear on the trees and sunlight lingers a little longer over the Avon / Lake Victoria, Stratford prepares for its most extraordinary transformation. What was a wintry town becomes a cultural capital, an artistic hub, a buzzing centre of performance, cuisine, craftsmanship, and conversation. The Stratford Festival — the jewel in our crown — is about to awaken.

This is a rhythm Stratford knows well. It is a dance we perform every year — the townspeople and downtown business owners, The restaurants, the artists and artisans, and the gardeners, all moving in step toward opening night. What we're about to welcome is more than tourism. It is a homecoming of culture and spirit. It is our city's most brilliant expression of identity.

Yes, the storm is coming. But it's not a storm to fear — it's one we invite. A storm of applause, laughter, dialogue, and inspiration. A storm of Shakespearean soliloquies and avant-garde interpretations. A storm that reminds us, once more, of Stratford's unique place on the world stage.

So here's to the calm — this quiet moment that holds a thousand unspoken preparations. And here's to the storm — may it sweep us up, shake us awake, and remind us why Stratford is unlike any other place on Earth.

Let's remember to open our doors and our hearts to all of our visitors and a special hug for our guests from the United States.
