





TECH TIPS



This month's theme: **Keeping visitors engaged and encouraging repeat visits - don't just get clicks, earn attention.**

Getting Started: Make pages easy to scan with clear headings, bullet points, and concise paragraphs, but reward visitors who explore further with small surprises. Subtle changes over time, seasonal highlights, or Easter

eggs hidden in interaction-based content (perhaps a special offer hidden in your FAQs?) will keep the site fresh for returning visitors, while staying approachable for first timers, and it promotes deeper engagement by everyone.

Going Further: Add simple interactive touches that draw attention without heavy effort. Scroll-driven animations, and subtle hover effects add dopamine-hits and keep users focused. Using offline and social media brand reference points in website pages ("as seen on our social!") makes things engaging for loyal customers and first time visitors alike, and encourages cross-platform interaction.

Growing & Scaling: Encourage repeat visits by offering dynamic, relevant content tailored to visitor behavior. Highlight related products, seasonal offerings, or trending items, and track engagement to see what keeps users exploring. Use this data to refine content and CTAs, creating a site that rewards curiosity and keeps visitors coming back.
